TO ALL THOSE REQUESTING OUR SERVICES:

CAIR FLIGHT INC. is a Volunteer Pilot Organization whose mission is to coordinate "Charitable Airlift Meeting Medical & Humanitarian Needs." We link volunteer pilots willing to fly on your behalf in an effort to meet your transportation needs in a safe and timely manner. CAIR FLIGHT is a unique form of community service made possible through the generosity of our pilots who generously donate their time, skills, and aircraft operation!

While our goal is to assist everyone who asks, we are volunteers and resource dependent, so there can be no guarantee of service. Recognizing our pilot's expenses may easily exceed \$150 per hour, we ask those that are able to purchase commercial travel to make those plans before contacting us. However, when public conveyance is unavailable, unaffordable, or medically prohibited (immune deficiency), we welcome your inquiry.

We will do our best to meet your schedule as closely as possible. Please allow at least one week for us to arrange a mission. Remember that safety is paramount; and if our pilot decides the mission cannot be safely completed due to weather or other considerations, we strongly suggest that you have a backup travel plan. Download, print & complete the MISSION REQUEST FORM on our website before contacting us. Either mail or scan and email back to us (Missions@CAIRflight.org). We cannot begin helping you without it.

If you are traveling for a specific appointment, be sure that is clearly noted on your form. We will need your doctor's complete contact info (and email). You must ask your physician to sign a travel Medical Release letter. That validates you are able to be transported aboard a general aviation aircraft that does not operate at altitudes requiring pressurization.
